BUILDING RENOVATIONS

Building renovations completed in 1922, 1973, 1998, and 2015.

Steel framed with a steel & concrete foundation, facade/curtain wall clad entirely in granite.

Windows are operable for cleaning purposes only.

BUILDING HOURS OF OPERATION

8a.m.-6p.m. Monday through Friday.

BUILDING ACCESS / SECURITY

Uniformed guards control the concierge desk 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

ELECTRICAL

8 watts per USF (usable square foot) demand load exclusive of floor AC units. Directly metered to Con Edison.

HVAC

Individual floor water, cooled, direct expansion packaged VAV units (excluding 22nd floor. The 22nd floor has modular chillers with ceiling mounted fan coil units). The base building system is a variable air volume system that permits the tenant to develop multiple zones within the demised space.

HEATING

The building is heated by Con Edison steam. The base building heating equipment and circulation pumps are located in the sub-basement of the building. Heating is provided by perimeter fin tube radiation on all floors with enclosures.

EMERGENCY POWER

An Allis Calmer Company emergency generator is located on the roof. The generator has a capacity of 125 kW at 120/208 volt, three phase, four wire, and serves stair emergency lighting and base building, fire/life safety systems and elevators.

LIFE SAFETY SYSTEM

A state-of-the-art analog addressable fire alarm system serves the building. The fire command station is located adjacent to the lobby concierge's desk and data gathering panels (DGP's) are located on every third floor throughout the building. The fire alarm system has sufficient capacity for tenant additions. Each floor is supplied with two speaker circuits, two strobe circuits, for ADA compliance (i.e. strobe lights). a door release circuit at each DGP and addressable loop for the addition of smoke detectors, heat detectors, etc. Building is provided with 3" sprinkler rig floor control assembly at each tenant floor located in stair.

TELECOM

Vertical and horizontal spaces have been allocated to receive fiber optic

communication facilities for tenant use. A vertical communication riser is available at each floor. The current telecommunication providers are Verizon, Cogent & Time Warner Cable.

WIRED CERTIFIED GOLD

100 Broadway is a Wired Certified Gold building with multiple fiber providers and fully diverse points of entry to allow tenants to procure primary and back-up service offerings through completely separate entrances. Telecom cables are kept in a protected, secure riser to minimize risk and additional riser space.
